

Customized current/temperature DWEZ program for Bluestar Chiller application

Application Details

- Master Follower Application without wiring any Digital Signals or Analog Signals between the two Drives was implemented and tested.
- Information can be shared with the implemented Memobus / RS485 ports of the VFD .
- Remote IO functions blocks available with DWEZ programming feature was utilized to achieve the same.
- However fault feedback and trip command was taken in hardwire due to safety concerns.

Application Details

- DWEZ program was developed along with built in comparator function available in GA700 for detecting DC bus voltage.
- Customer wants to set a higher and lower limit for current levels so that a feedback can be given to the controller during abnormal operation.
- Similar feedback was given to the controller based on the temperature levels to prevent any abnormal operation and result in failure of machine.
