[National Holidays in Japan]

New Year's Day	It's a day on which the birth of the new year is celebrated with Osechi and Ozouni. Very few people work on the first three days of the new year.
Coming-of-Age Day	It's a day for congratulating those who have reached 20 years of age. Each local government holds a congratulatory ceremony for them on this day. Women wear gorgeous kimono called furisode on this ceremony.
National Foundation Day	It's a day for commemorating the foundation of the nation marked by the accession to the throne of the first emperor in the year 660 B.C.
Emperor's Birthday	It's a day to celebrate the birthday of His Majesty the Emperor. On this day he receives the congratulations of the nation with his family at the Imperial Place.
Autumnal Equinox Day	It's a day when the length of day and night is almost the same. people honor their ancestors, recalling the deceased, and visit family graves on or around this day.
Showa Day	It's a day for reflecting on the events of the Showa period under the reign of Emperor Hirohito (Emperor Showa). This holiday was originally celebrated as the Emperor's Birthday during his lifetime.
Constitution Memorial Day	It's a day for commemorating the promulgation of the present constitution. The Constitution came into force on this day in 1947 as one of the postwar reforms by the Allies.
Greenery Day	It's a day formerly celebrated as Emperor Hirohito's Birthday. This day is now set aside in remembrance of the late emperor's love of nature.
Children's Day	It's a day traditionally the Boy's Festival, as compared with the Festival of Dolls for girls on March 3. Wishes for the healthy growth of boys are represented on this day by setting out warrior figures in houses and hoisting carp-shaped streamers on poles.
Marine Day	It's a day for expressing gratitude for the bounty of the sea, honoring its importance and praying for the prosperity of Japan as a maritime nation. Prior to it becoming a national holiday, this day had been known as "Marine Memorial Day" since 1941.
Mountain Day	It's a day intended to give opportunities to get familiar with mountains and appreciate blessings from mountains. It was celebrated from August 11 2016.
Respect-for-the Aged Day	It's a day for showing respect and affection for the elderly, who have devoted local government sends small gifts to the elderly.
Sports Day	It was designated to commemorate the opening day of the Tokyo Olympics held in 1964.
Culture Day	It's a day for promoting culture. People of cultural merit are awarded medals at the Imperial Palace. Many cultural events are held throughout the nation on or around this day. Formerly it was a national holiday called "Meiji-setsu" commemorating the birthday of Emperor Meiji who was born on November 3, 1852.
Labor Thanksgiving Day	It's a day for expressing gratitude for the benefits of labor and production.
Substitute Holiday	If a national holiday falls on a Sunday, the following day substitutes for it to make a long weekend.
